Prof. N R Kamath, known for his remarkable achievements in the fields of plastics, paints, polymers & shellac, was also the first ever Head of Department of Chemical Engineering, IIT Bombay. Prof. N R Kamath completed his BSc (Hons.) degree, followed by BSc (Tech.) in Chemical Engineering from the Bombay University. He went on to complete his Post Graduate Diploma in Chemical Engineering from the University College, London. In the 7 years he spent at London Shellac Research Bureau, he went on to bring out 18 publications on the utilization of lac. He joined IIT-Bombay in 1958 as a professor in the Department of Chemical Engineering. He then went on it become it's first HOD & also the Deputy Director of the Institute. He has served on several committees of the govt. & has been a recipient of several honours & awards. After retiring in 1974, he worked as an advisor to several industries. He even served as the President of IChE during 1974-75.

Young turks battle it out

State-level chemical engineering quiz held in Navi Mumbai. Sparsh Sharma reports

FEST ROUND-UP

THE PRESENTATION N R Kamath Trophy was at Delta Meeh College of Engineering, Navi Mumbai.

On March 5, the college hosted a state-level chemical engineering quiz and exhibition 'Young Turks - 2008' (Chemical Engineering Quiz - 2008). It is a yearly student quiz organized by the Mumbai regional centre of Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers and hosted by different colleges.

Staff Prasad Balakrishna, convenor and fourth year student of the host college, "Only chemical engineering students can participate in CHEE. We had eight teams in all. There were two preliminary rounds. So just four teams reached the final round at Mumbai. Chemistry Institute of Chemical Technology (ICICT), St. Andrews, NICE, Theoretical Institute were the finalists.

"We also had an exhibition on various aspects of the field of chemical engineering," said Prasad Deshpande, a third year student of the host college who came up with the idea.

The size of the exhibition was to introduce young students from this branch to industrial chemical equipments and industrial pollution control equipments along with their functions and uses, he said.

The quiz began the trophy along with a cash prize of Rs 10,000.

From Mumbai and its suburbs, St. Andrews and Balakrishna had sent their representative teams to contest the trophy. "The students of the college had started preparing for the event in the month of January.

Sanjay Joshi and Prasad Deshpande were the chief guests. Both are in the chemical engineering industry. St. Andrews, a professor from IIT, Prasad, was the guest-in-chief in the preliminary rounds while in the final round, it was the turn of Dr S. Shreevast from IICET.

"Knowledge of all fields of chemical engineering is needed here. We could never assume our faculty members are strong," said Parashad, a third year participant and student of Theoretical Institute College of Engineering.

THE LIFE AND TIMES OF PROFESSOR N R KAMATH

Late Professor N R Kamath remains an eminent personality in the chemical field and is also a source of inspiration for students.

He was born on 28th September 1924 in Malvi, Karnataka.

He is an inspired 8th honours from University of Mumbai in 1954. He further did his BSc in chemical engineering from Institute of London and joined Institute from University College of London and joined Indian Institute of Technology in 1960 as 30 years tenure reader in technology of plastics, paints and varnishes.

He was the first head of the department in IIT Powai in 1962 and became deputy director in 1968.

He is retired from IIT in 1974. He was a member of Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers from May 1968 till his death in July 2003.

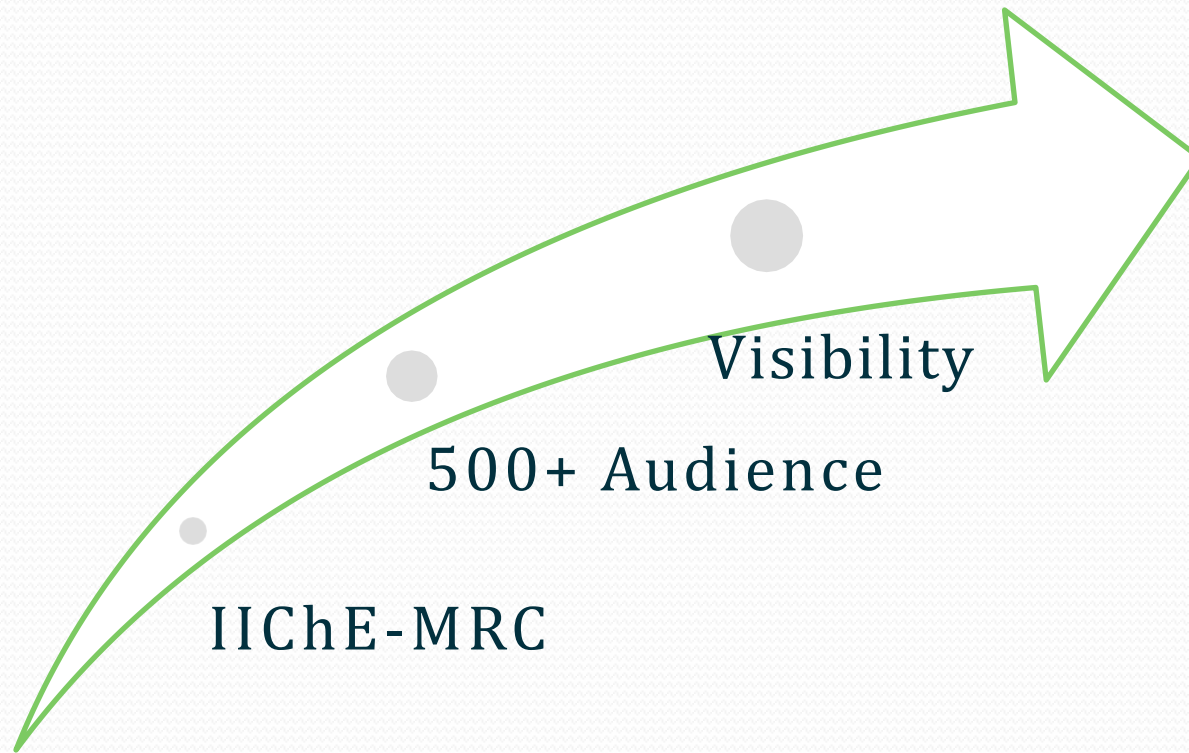
